

Dr. Simone Peter is the chairwoman of the German Green party (Bündnis 90/Die Grünen) since 2013 and an expert on climate and energy policy, sustainable development and the green economy.

She was minister for the environment, energy and transportation of the state of Saarland from 2009 to 2012, promoting renewable sources of energy and energy efficiency in the coal rich region and implementing Germany's energy transition ("Energiewende") from fossil fuels to renewables on the state level.

Before that, she was executive director of the Berlin based German Agency for Renewable Energy and editor in charge of the magazine "Solarzeitalter (Solar Age)" published by the European Association for Renewable Energy.

Dr. Simone has a PhD in biology from the University of Saarbruecken.
